

ANESTHESIA MODIFIERS

The following list of modifiers are the only modifiers that should be used when submitting claims for anesthesia services for Medicaid (MSCAN):

- AA **AA definition:** Anesthesia services performed personally by the Anesthesiologist
- GC GC definition: This service has been performed in part by a Resident under the direction of a teaching physician
- QX **QX definition:** CRNA service with medical direction by a physician
- QZ QZ definition: CRNA service without medical direction by a physician

Billing the QX Modifier

 To be consistent with correct coding standards for modifier QX, and that of the description for modifier QX –effective 01/01/2020 – Physicians will no longer be reimbursed for modifier QX, as this code is only valid for CRNAs.

The following list of modifiers are NOT allowed in Medicaid (MSCAN):

- QK QK definition: Medical direction of two, three or four concurrent anesthesia procedures involving qualified individuals
- QY QY definition: Medical direction of one Certified Registered Nurse Anesthetist by an Anesthesiologist



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
